- I. Welcome and Introduction – Mike Lorback opened the meeting at 4:30 and welcomed and introduced everyone.
- II. Share the Wealth – Thank you notes will be sent out to Angelo's Sport Shop, Bobby Warshaw and Andy Wenger for their donations for the raffle. At this point, \$1291 has been raised and only \$968 has been spent, so there is money for Gerry to use for shipping.
- III. Minutes – the minutes were presented for the January 26, 2013 meeting and the January 18, 2014 meeting in Philadelphia. Motion by Glenn Hibshman and seconded by Randy Behney to accept the minutes. Motion passed.
- IV. Committee Reports
  - a. Treasurer's Report – The Treasurer's report was presented by Randy Behney and the PSCA is in good financial shape. Randy will check on the All-American game ad to see if our ad was in the program. Glenn Hibshman made a motion to invest \$10,000 in a conservative investment. Seconded by Dave Hartlaub. Motion passed. Dave Hartlaub motioned to donate \$500 for the JP Dorsey Fund which helps inner city children. Seconded by Brandon Ramsey and motion passed.
    - i. Randy presented next year's budget. There was one change. \$500 was added to the scholarship fund. Motion was made by Randy Rich and seconded by Bob Black.
    - ii. Banquet – Next year's banquet will be held January 31, 2015, at the Camp Hill Radisson. We also have to look for a new photographer for next year.
  - b. Membership– Tony Cavallaro stated that there are 751 members this year. We are still missing a few league reps. Tony will send out an email to the non-members to get an increase in enrollment.
  - c. Sponsorships - Brine has agreed to another three-year sponsorship. Tony talked to the other three sponsors at the convention and they are all pleased.
  - d. Website – No Report
  - e. All-State and All-American
    - i. Boys – Brandon will work with Pat to make it so the online form is running better. Pennsylvania has less All-Region and All-American players because of the decrease in

NSCAA members. We will check with NSCAA to see if all of our members are being counted.

- ii. Girls – Keith wants to make it easier to find the links for the All-State forms.
- f. Coach of the Year – Scott stated that 36 out of 56 voted this year. The deadline was moved back one week for NSCAA which will give us more time to select the COY from coaches that are in state playoffs. He would also like to look in to handling COY online.
- g. Hall of Fame, Honor Award, and Service Award Committee – Randy stated again that the biggest problem is getting names from all over the state. It was decided that Tony will send out a newsletter to all members to try to get more names of people that would qualify for these awards.
- h. Soccer Polls
  - i. Boys/Girls – Glenn and Dan stated that the soccer poll is just for fun and create interest. They did have most of the teams in the state finals rated high. Any people who want to give information from other areas of the state are encouraged to contact Glenn for the Boys and Dan for the Girls. They also look at sending a mass email for the first poll so that everyone is aware it exists and take them to the website for more information.

#### V. New Business

- a. Next meeting dates
  - i. NSCAA Convention January 14-18, 2015, Philadelphia, PA. Social will be the same as this year since it was a great success. Mike did an outstanding job.
  - ii. PSCA Annual meeting after the All-State Banquet on January 31, 2015, which is two weeks after the national convention and will be at the Radisson.
- b. NSCAA
  - i. NFHS surveys have not been getting to the coaches so Mike will look into having the surveys go directly to PSCA so the survey can get to the members.
  - ii. Registration discounts – NSCAA will continue with their black Friday discounts because they are trying to get more people enrolled.
  - iii. Retirees and membership – Mike will check to see if retirees are listed on the PA roles so that we have a larger number of members for All-Region and All-American selections.
  - iv. All-State certificates – PSCA will continue to use our own certificates.
- c. One Touch Communication App – Mike and Tony will look into this app.
- d. Top Drawer National Publication – High School coverage – Tom and Mike will look into this publication.
- e. Recruiting/Assignments – Many of the officers and chairs are getting older. We need to recruit some young coaches to get involved with PSCA.
- f. Open Discussion – PSCA Assistant Coach of the Year – NSCAA has had this award for many years and we have not had such a category. Randy Rich made a motion and seconded that PSCA select an Assistant Coach of the Year. Motion passed. Dave Hartlaub motioned and seconded by Bob Black that Chris Zalasky become the Chair. Motion passed.
